



Safety on your SPCA visit

To ensure everyone enjoys their visit to the Auckland SPCA Animal Village we ask that your organization makes the group aware of your own behavioural expectations. Enjoy your visit and thanks for thinking of us!

On your visit to us we expect the following:

Confirm booking with SPCA and ensure bus driver knows where to go (see attached map)

Report to front reception on arrival

Children must have adequate footwear **NO BARE FEET!**

Please bring a donation of either cat/kitten/dog/puppy food, money, old towels, blankets, jumpers

and...

No running, please walk in the village

No tapping on the animal cages

No shouting at the animals or each other

No teasing, including mimicking of the animals

No entering of cages or fenced areas, stay behind barriers at all times

No feeding (our animals have special diets and you might make them sick)

No fingers in the cages

No balls, hacky sacks, frisbees

No bikes, skateboards, roller blades or scooters
