



Volunteer Foster Parent Job Description

Major Objective

- To increase opportunities for more suitable animals to be adopted by supporting suitable animals to reach the adoption criteria for their species

Responsibilities

- To feed, socialize, groom, train and medicate animals sheltered in your home
- To ensure the safety of all foster animals under the foster parent's care
- To isolate foster pets from household pets (if necessary)
- To ensure that your own pets have current vaccinations
- To observe and report any problems to the Foster Coordinators
- To return all foster animals to the Auckland SPCA

Qualifications

- Background knowledge of animal care

Training Required

- Completion of primary screening for Foster Volunteer Program
- Completion of Foster Care Workshop Canine and/or Feline
- Property inspection by Auckland SPCA representative (if required)

Time and Place

- You will foster animals in your home. Each foster care contract lasts from one week to three months, depending on the animal's situation and needs.

Benefits

- Continuing animal care and behaviour education whenever possible
- Recognition events and social events with SPCA volunteers and staff
- Discounts on pet supplies from the Auckland SPCA shop
- Discounted animal adoption fees
- Inclusion in our Volunteer of the Month programme
